Your 'virtual' caddy will tell you all the distances you need when you need them on the golf course.

What it is

A Caddy is a portable hand held device which uses GPS technology to tell golfers all the distances they need on the golf course.

What it does

Before a game of golf, the player can download the course map and the virtual caddy will use GPS technology to guide them around the course.

Helping your game

Your caddy will automatically provide you with the distances you need on each and every hole. At all times throughout a hole your caddy will display (in the top row of the display) the distance to the front of the green you are playing – EVEN if you are on an adjoining fairway or through the green. You will also know how far it is TO or TO CARRY up to three primary hazards on each hole: Bunkers, Water, Dog Legs, Fairway Run Out, Hollows or Paths etc. As these hazards become out of play, the large element of the display (visible from over 20ft away) will automatically change to the Front of the Green, Centre of Green and Back of Green.

Features

Hands free operation: Your caddy is designed so that you can switch it on as you arrive at the club, select the course you are playing on the day and your caddy will give you the distances you require for your entire round of golf. After selecting your course you **SHOULD NOT NEED TO TOUCH YOUR CADDY AGAIN** until the round of golf is completed. No need to fiddle, press buttons or interrupt your game OR your playing partners game. Your caddy will automatically detect which hole it is on and give you the distances you need when you need them.

Easy to use: Your caddy is supplied with a simple to install and easy to use software application. The caddy allows you to set up simple owner preferences. Are you male or female? (important for the Information on each hole – such as stroke, index and Par). Do you want distance information in Yards or Metres? And what do you want to call your Caddy?

About maps: Wherever you might buy your caddy from, it will include at least 1 Caddy Map (or 1 Map Credit), either: the Caddy Map of your choice if you buy from the web or if you buy it from a pro shop the Caddy Map of the course from where it was purchased could be included. NB. If the unit is purchased from a retail store not associated with a particular golf course, you will receive one credit to download the Caddy Map of your choice when you first connect to the web at golf.sisirl.com



Caddy Maps
For your Caddy to work on a particular course it needs to be loaded with a Caddy Map. A Caddy Map is a set of Latitude and Longitude reference points which represent the key hazard points of the hole and the Front, Centre & Back of the Green.

Know your distance: Your Caddy is designed for Hands free use. However, if you want to record the distance achieved by each club in the bag, either during a practice session or a round of golf, you can do. Your Caddy will measure the distance for any club in the bag. Your Caddy will also record and measure your distances of each club for you so that it will even know which club to recommend for any given distance.

Caddy maps: For your caddy to work on a particular course it needs to be loaded with a Caddy Map. This is a set of latitude and longitude reference points which represent the key hazard points of the hole and the front, centre and back of the green.

Your caddy courses: The Golf Plus mapping team are mapping more and more courses each week. By the end of 2006, there will be more than 1750 Caddy Maps of the top courses in Ireland and the UK to choose from. During 2007 we will start mapping in the top courses in Europe.
